

## Year 10 Hans Kimmel Progress Report

The guidelines below are to assist you in working methodically on your Hans Kimmel assignment.

You are required to complete four diary entries, but you may want to write more, keeping a note of your personal responses to your research and interaction with the people whom you contact.

This diary will not be assessed as part of your Hans Kimmel submission, but your teachers will take them in at least once to ensure you are on track.

Self-evaluation: After each entry, locate your position on a scale of 1 - 10, with 10 being the finished project.

Entry 1 Due Date

- 1. Identify the topic you have chosen for your research.
- 2. Briefly outline how you plan to proceed, for example:

Identify people you will need to contact, and how you will contact them (some people may not live in Sydney and you may need to write letters, use e-mail/ the Internet)

Identify people you plan to interview and try and set a time for these.

It is better to conduct a series of interviews rather than one long interview.

It is a good idea to use a tape recorder/video camera during interviews so that you can refer to this when you begin writing up your project.

3. Start looking for resources for the historical component of the essay. Keep details, as you will need to include a detailed bibliography.

Entry 2 Due Date:

- 1. Formulate lists of questions you want to ask people, and keep a list of questions you need to research
- 2. Keep note of the progress you have made with your primary major research eg. the documents you may have gathered, maps you intend including, photographs you have.
- 3. Comment on your secondary research progress covering the period and the place of focus.
- 4. Outline your next steps towards completing your project





Entry 3 Due Date:

1. Comment on the progress of your writing and editing

- 2. Consider how you will integrate the historical research and the primary research.
- 3. Begin planning how you will present your project and what title you will give it.
- 4. Outline your next steps towards completing your project

Entry 4 Due Date:

- 1. Final copy should be ready to write up/type.
- 2. Detailed bibliography should be prepared
- 3. Maps should be drawn and clearly labelled
- 4. Photographs should be carefully explained
- 5. You should write an introduction and a conclusion to your essay, explaining why you have chosen your topic and your personal comments about what you have gained from this project.
- 6. Consider binding your project, presenting it in a good folder, because we hope you will keep this document as a valuable family record.

We hope that you will find this a most rewarding undertaking – as your teachers, we regard it as one of our most rewarding project to assess.
